Dear Friends of the House of One,

Over the past month, the terrorist attack of Christchurch has cast its shadow. Fifty people died because they wanted to pray in a mosque. "The world is trapped in a vicious circle of extremism that produces even more extremism. This must end. We cannot do this alone. The answer lies in our humanity," said Jacinda Ardern, New Zealand's Prime Minister, during the funeral service two weeks after the multiple murder. A meaningful message.

Hate is destructive no matter from which direction it comes. To counter this hatred, whether it appears as anti-Semitism, Islamophobia, Christian hatred or under any other name, the people in the House of One also see this as their central task. Encounter, dialogue and trust are the paths we have chosen to take for this purpose. "We - Jews, Christians and Muslims - stand side by side, because all people, regardless of what they believe, are part of a human family", said Pastor Gregor Hohberg during the prayer for peace on 20 March 2019

in Berlin, to which we had invited in memory of the victims and those left behind by the assassination of Christchurch. Defending humanity requires all of you. We cannot do this alone.

Review

Peace prayer for Christchurch

Five days after the assassination attempt in New Zealand, the House of One invited to an interreligious prayer for peace in the Parochial Church in Berlin. No candles were lit in the austere, unadorned room, and instrumental music was also dispensed with as muslim tradition demands. Only from the tower of the church the glockenspiel with "Oh Haupt voll

Blut und Wunden" sounded at 6 pm. As soon as the music had stopped, Imam Kadir Sanci, Rabbi Andreas Nachama and Pastor Greogr Hohberg appeared before the sixty or so people who had gathered to commemorate and comfort each other. Safiyye Aydin, a visitor, said it was very relieving that other religions showed sympathy. "We share the grief. And if we share the sorrow, it will become less", said the young Muslim woman to Deutsche Welle. More...

Cardinal Nzapalainga at the House of One: Together with Imam Layama Kobine and the Protestant pastor Philippe Sing-Na the two other leaders of the great religions in the Central African Republic, Cardinal Dieudonné Nzapalainga visited the House of One, whose project ambassadors are also the clergy. For years the clergy have been working together for peace in their country, which has been repeatedly shaken by armed struggles. In Berlin, the

Berlin leaves building site to House of One for one euro

At the beginning of March, the Senate decided to give the House of One Foundation the building plot in the heart of the capital for a symbolic annual ground rent of one euro for 99 years. In addition, the Governing Mayor Michael Müller (SPD) has promised to chair the future Board of Trustees of the Foundation. "With this decision, the Senate acknowledges the great importance of the House of One," said Senator of Culture Klaus Lederer (Die Linke). "It will stand as a worldwide role model for tolerance, openness, successful dialogue and constructive coexistence of religions in a pluralistic city. The contract is currently being drawn up. Arabic - Door opener to muslim culture

The House of One Foundation has expanded its interreligious education work to include Arabic lessons as part of its dialogue mandate. So far, the two Arabic teachers, who have been working since November, offer weekly language classes to pupils of the 5th and 6th grades of the Evangelische Schule Berlin Mitte (ESBM).
