

CHURCH AND WAR CRIMES

Research assignment: Where the House of One is being built, Pastor Hoff, an ardent anti-Semite, led the congregation of St. Peter during the Nazi-Regime in Berlin

Where Jews, Christians and Muslims are jointly planning the House of One in Berlin, an ardent anti-Semite, Pastor Walter Hoff, preached from the pulpit of St. Peter's Church during the Third Reich. The Protestant house of worship, on whose foundations the multi-religious House of One is being built, was damaged in World War II and finally demolished in the 1960s by the government of the GDR. It seems that with it, the memory of the Nazi past of the congregation and its pastor was also erased. "We want to break with this long-standing tradition of looking away," says Rabbi Andreas Nachama of the House of One, who is also chairman of the General Rabbinical Conference in Germany. "And it reminds us to resolutely oppose any form of anti-Semitism and other inhuman hatred also today."
